## Fun with Collage and Mosaic





## Tile Coasters Craft Kit



Easy to do, fun to make! Design unique coasters by simply gluing tile into place. Students may wish to use wood stain or paint to color the wood coasters before gluing the tiles in place. Pop out center from the top piece, line up the sides and glue the two pieces of your coaster together. Let dry, you may want to place a heavy object on top to keep pieces together while drying. Apply glue with the brush or your fingers inside the recessed area of the coaster and spread onto entire area. Press the tiles in place in rows of five. Let dry. Wipe any excess glue from the tops of the tiles with a damp cloth. . Includes tiny tile, precut wood coasters, school glue and brushes. 3-1/2" square.

## Cover-it Photo Frame with Magnet



Personalize your picture frames by gluing and decorating with the double sided colored mosaic squares of paper. Or you can also use markers, paint, glitter, or wrap with specialty papers (not Included) . To assemble frame, apply glue to one side of the center piece (U shape) and glue to the back solid piece. Apply glue to the other side of the center piece and apply to the front of the frame making sure the center top is open for picture. Remove adhesive backing on magnet and apply, you may have to add more glue to the back of the magnet. Frames includes elmer's glue, mosaic squares and adhesive-backed magnetic strip. Sturdy poster board holds 1-1/2" x 2" student photos.

## Tissue squares for covering Vase or Mason Jar



Find an old vase or jar laying around the house. Let your student glue the tissue to the outside of a clean vase or jar. Use the white Elmer's glue included in the art pack. Glue pieces of the tissue covering the whole outside of the vase or jar. Let dry. You can then spray with a clear acrylic for a more lasting finish or simply wipe a coat of the white Elmer's glue over the whole outside and let dry.

## Montage Style Collage




A montage is a distinct kind of collage. It is made from sections of a magazine picture or other photographs. The artist glues down the photo together in a new way.

Make a copy of your favorite photo. You can copy them in color or black and white.

Cut the photo into squares or in strips. Move the shapes apart or up and down. Be real creative and combine different pictures in one. Try different arrangements and then glue down on the provided card stock. Fold the card stock in half to create a card if you'd like.

# Additional Fun!

## Clothespin Airplane with Magnet



Use the clothespin and craft sticks to make an airplane. Make sure to apply the glue heavy using the glue stick. After you complete the plane glue the magnet on the bottom under the wing so the magnet won't be seen. Let dry. Makes a great refrigerator magnet!
