

Maker Woodworking Class-January, grades 1-2

Blurb:

This Maker class will be an opportunity for the students to learn how to use woodworking tools such as sandpaper, a screwdriver, manual hand drill, hammer and nails, mineral oil, and wood glue. After practicing with these tools they will be presented with a problem statement in which they will be encouraged to create something from wood that will respond to the statement. A sample problem statement would be "Create something that will bring more birds to the park." Wood tools and pieces as well as other materials will be available for the students to use in their creations.

Problem Question:

The garden fairies are bored and need something to entertain them. Create something that will bring excitement or joy to their lives.

1. tiles
2. ribbon
3. yarn
4. jewels
5. buttons
6. material scraps
7. wooden clothespins
