





# Fall Following Directions Activity

## Instructions:

your students to take out some colored pencils or crayons. Read the directions to your students. Your students Give each of your students a copy of the worksheet on page 1. Choose the difficulty level below and instruct should follow the directions exactly.

## 1 Step Directions

Color the squirrel green.
Circle the pinecone.
Draw a square around the pumpkin.
Put an "X" on the acorn.
Put a dot on the corn.
Draw a star next to the turkey.
Draw a line above the leaf.
Draw an arrow pointing at the squirrel.
Draw a triangle around the owl.
Color the fox blue.

## 2 Step Directions

Before you color the corn, draw a square next to the pinecone. Circle the turkey, then draw a line under the squirrel.

Color the acorn yellow, then draw a line above the owl.

Draw a square around the leaf, then color the pinecone blue.

After you put a heart around the pumpkin, color the leaf.

Before you color the pumpkin, put a triangle next to the pinecone. Draw an arrow next to the leaf before you color the fox.

Draw an "X" on the squirrel and circle the fox.


Draw a line through the pinecone and leaf, then circle the owl.

Draw a line between the acorn and pumpkin, and color the paint.

## Conditional Directions


If you are under the age of 10, circle the pinecone; otherwise circle the acorn. If September comes before March during the calendar year, circle the owl. If today is Friday, color the acorn brown; otherwise, color the acorn yellow. Color the squirrel blue if you have art today; Otherwise, color it orange. If you colored the acorn yellow, color the pumpkin green. Color the owl and pinecone, but not the squirrel.

If today is a weekday, write your name above the pinecone.
